

HEAD-ON COLLISIONS

Serious injury and extensive vehicle damage are common results of collisions between two vehicles in motion – whether head-on, front-to-side or front-to-rear. Do not let yourself get caught in a collision caused by another driver's actions.

Constantly scan the road ahead for vehicles entering your lane. Watch for the vehicle entering the roadway from a side road, from a driveway or parking lot, or one that is passing another vehicle.

- Yield to vehicles on your right.
- Reduce your speed in plenty of time.
- Veer right and off to the shoulder if necessary, giving up your lane.
